Chorus is manufactured to the highest technical and environmental standards. The product is made at Europe's most advanced coated paper mill. Partially integrated, manufacturing paper and pulp on site, therefore reducing energy consumption and carbon output. More than 80% of the total energy consumption of the mill comes from renewable sources - mostly biomass. The mill which makes Chorus sources 90% of its pulp fibre from within a 200km radius of the mill, further reducing the carbon footprint for production.

Emblem Greyboard is a board that is made entirely of recovered paper.
